

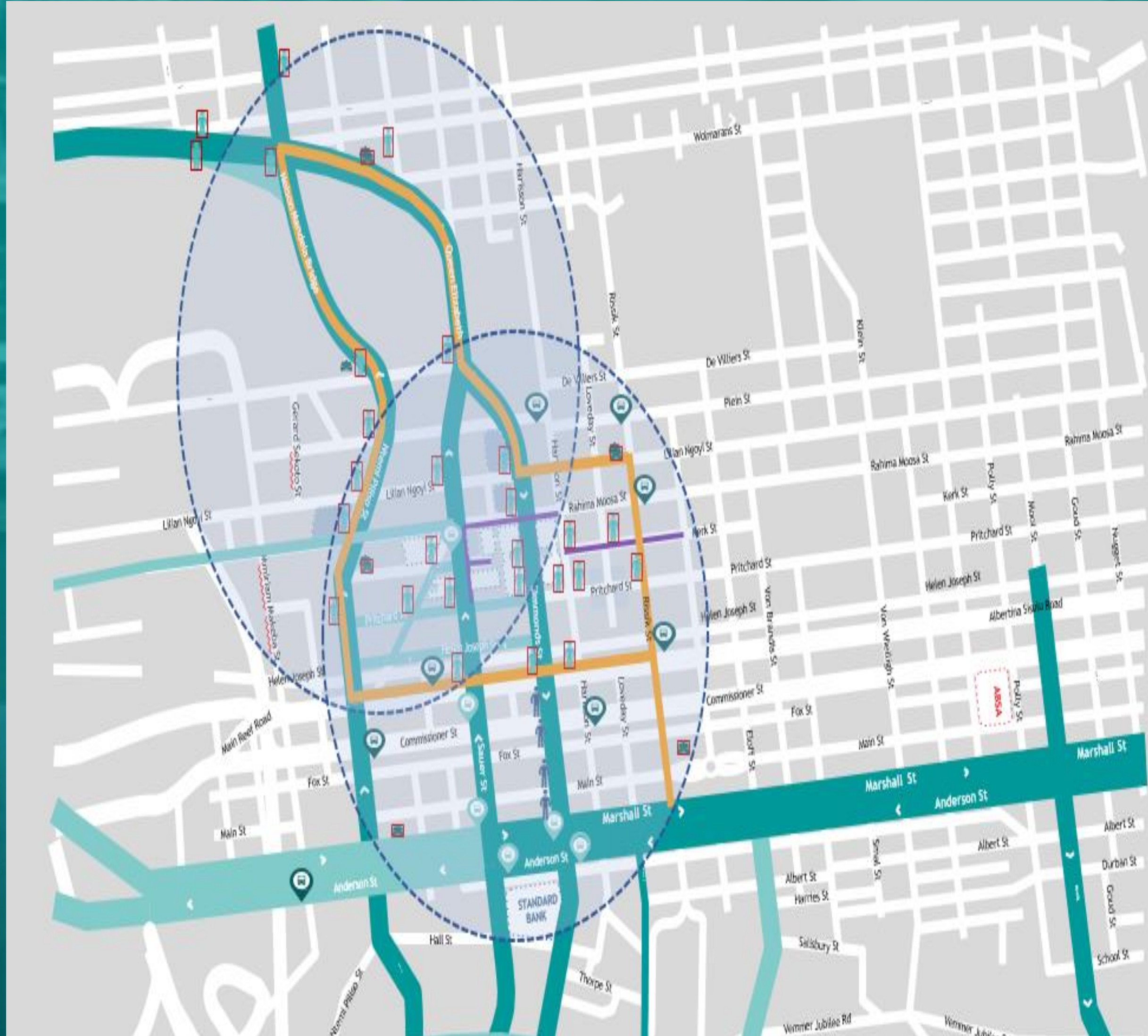

The FNB Precinct



The FNB Ecosystem, consisting of ten buildings, is a community operating interdependently within the Johannesburg CBD

Our investment in this community includes:

- R31 million spent on precinct security
- FirstRand's Gauteng property portfolio has a market value of R10.3 billion
- Disaster Recovery Management
- Ongoing improvements to our buildings including energy efficiency and sustainability projects
- Security provided by 183 day shift guards and 54 night shift guard patrols
- 15 Community patrollers
- Sponsorship of vehicles patrolling 24 hours and bike patrols 12 hours a day, benefitting the surrounding community
- Shopping nodes supported by staff as well as the community

10 Buildings | 12000 Staff | 5000 Vehicles | 16 Branches | 82 ATM's within a 2 km radius

Totalling R 933 million

FNB's Investment in the Joburg CBD (2015 -2018)

- FNB Towers - R 293 million (inclusive of lift upgrade of R23 million)
- Fraser St upgrade budget - R 62 million
- FNB Palace Parkade (14 stories, 48 858 m²) - R 222 million
- 1066 Building (20 stories, 28 000 m²) - R 345 million
- Energy efficiency and PV (Solar Power) - R 11 million
